SUPPLY LIST

PAINTS

Bring good quality watercolor paints, at least 3 tubes or pans– minimum red, yellow, blue; add in a few of your favorite colors. As we are working with transparent colors, no black or white allowed. PLEASE! Do not bring acrylic paint to this class.

WATERCOLOR BRUSHES

- Several various size rounds, small to large
- One large flat, approx. 1”

OTHER SUPPLIES

Small palette for mixing paints

Two medium size water containers

Pair of sharp scissors

Black fine tip waterproof pen (Micron, Pitt, Sharpie)

Paper towels

#2 pencil

Art eraser (kneaded, Moo, etc.)

Glue stick, gel medium, Elmer’s (any strong thick paper glue will do)

Ruler

Plastic table cover (Dollar Tree has a good selection)

Optional, if you have them:

Bone folder

Any other supplies you may want to play with... Tombow dual brush pens, aqua pastels, watercolor pencils, water soluble crayons, etc.)

Watercolor/mixed media paper and bookbinding materials will be supplied by the instructor.

Important!

We are experimenting and playing with supplies you may have no experience with. I do not want you to spend a lot of money for supplies you do not have. I will have some supplies available for you to try and share.
