

Exploring Abstract Art in Mixed Media with Katra Peck

Supplies

Bienfang 18x24 Heavy weight drawing paper (any brand as long as it is heavy weight and accepts wet media.)

Canson Mixed media sketch book 11x14 (can be other brands)

Silicone Painting Brush Color Shaper Tool 1" and 2" Amazon sells a set of these \$11.99
You can get these at other art stores also.

Messer Meister Bowl Scraper (yes, this is a painting tool) You can get this one later but would like you to have the 1" and 2" shaper tool to start.

Painter tape 1", the blue tape works fine and you can get at Home Depot or Lowes

Black China marker (they also have sets with additional colors)

Pencil, black sharpie marker, any oil pastels or soft pastels (fixative if you use soft pastels) you have They have different sets at Michaels and a small set is fine. If you have any other markers or paint pens you can also use those but they aren't necessary to begin with.

Acrylic paint, any brand

black, white, primary red, primary blue, primary yellow

Any acrylic paints you have you can use. With the primary colors you can mix colors to start if you don't already have paint.

acrylic painting medium (glossy or) matte

Paint brushes, whatever you have. They have inexpensive brush sets at Michaels.

A fine liner brush

Palette knife (can be plastic or metal)

Sponge brushes are good to use also but not necessary at all.

Please bring a table cover for your work area, paper towels for cleaning your brushes, and a container for water to clean your brushes in.

A palette box for your paint or you can just use paper plates or freezer paper.
