

## Supply List for Introduction to Quilting – Nancy Anson

Sewing machine and accessories.  
Zipper foot if your machine has one.  
Walking foot if it has one.  
Bobbins.  
EXTRA sewing machine needles.  
Thread the color of your fabric or medium gray.  
Iron.  
Small ironing board.  
Electrical extension cord.

Seam Ripper.  
Scissors.  
Straight pins.  
Pens, pencils, note book or paper.

If you have these bring them. There are several places that sell a starter kit that includes all three from Fiskars:

Rotary cutter 9mm.  
Quilting ruler.  
Self-healing rotary cutting mat.

Fabric Requirements: Fabric Requirements will be given at the first class when you pick a pattern you feel fits your abilities. You may work on the project at home if you feel comfortable, as the class goes on. It is best to use good quality quilt cotton from a local quilt shop. There are several in the area.

Do not feel you have to purchase fabric prior to class if you have questions about fabric or color, you can wait and buy your fabric prior to the second class.  
I have fabrics that you can practice on for the first class.

### 1: Fabric Requirements for the Pillow

1 yard of backing fabric\*  
3-4 fat quarters\* various colors  
1/2 yard of background fabric for front\*  
20 inch zipper for pillow

### 2: Fabric for Pumpkin in Flower Patch

4-5 fat quarters in solid/small print orange colors  
½ yard backing fabric your choice  
½ yard large print flowers/leaves etc.

### 3: Fabric for Christmas Tree Wall hanging

I will supply the batting and fabric for the first class.

A rolling suitcase is a great way to transport a sewing machine and sewing supplies.
