

## YUPO WORKSHOP - MATERIALS

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YUPO PAPER WILL BE SUPPLIED BY THE INSTRUCTOR. STUDENTS WILL NEED TO BRING THE FOLLOWING:

**Fresh, juicy paint.** No dried-up blobs, please; these are very difficult to reconstitute into the required viscosity. Have tubes of fresh paint available if necessary. Use your favorite colors.

### EQUIPMENT

- Blue painter's tape
- Kleenex for blotting (toilet paper will also work)
- Paper towels – Viva is the best, but any type will do
- Spray bottle that has adjustable nozzle to create heavier drops or a nice **mist**
- Your usual brushes including a 1" flat. A larger wash brush (1 ½ + inches) is optional but nice to have
- Water containers
- Blow dryer - optional

**Photo references** will be supplied by the instructor

### Have at least a couple of these:

- Stencils – any kind - optional
- Water soluble pencils or crayons
- Texture materials – a couple of these of your choice: bubble wrap, waxed paper, plastic wrap, cardboard, stamps of any kind, any household objects that can leave a mark. Plastic grid for needle point also works well.
